Steven Beckers

Architect Steven Beckers, since diploma work in 1984, awarded Aga Khan and "African Technical Association" prize develops a global approach on sustainability in architecture and urban planning, with Geneva Gaillard Architect, is awarded the jury prize on environmental urban planning for Wilson Palace proposal Geneva. European director with London firm EPR architects from 1986 till 1996, he is founding member of Architecturo EEIG in 1990 with whom he wins the "Green Office European award with EXPO 98 HQ in Lisbon. As head of Architecture for Berlaymont 2000, he is awarded the PLEA Passive and Low Energy Architecture award in Cambridge 2000. From 2000 till 2010, partner with Art&Build Architects, he is selected by Greenpeace for their HQ in Brussels, by the Council of Europe for Agora, Pharmacopea and nursery buildings in Strasburg and receives BEX, MIPIM, LEAF and RICS awards. Steven Beckers is now independent registered Cradle to Cradle architect/consultant, Master of Conference at BATir ULB university, vice president of CD of Seco building control, consultant to IFMA for "Architecture-Facilities Management integration", founding member of Local Solutions Development Group ASBL already active in Africa and founding partner of "Lateral Thinking Factory", supporting projects according to the Cradle to Cradle principles with a multidisciplinary network of world experts, including Michael Braungart and William Mc Donough and their team.
